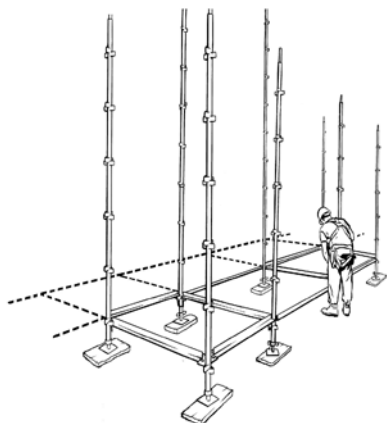


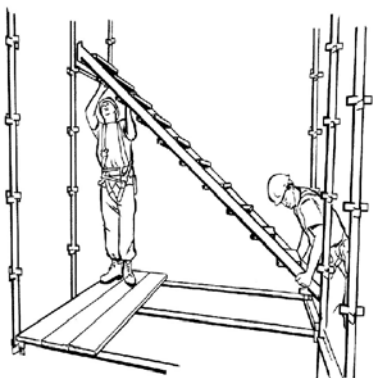
# GENSTAGE STAIRTOWER ERECTION GUIDE

## STEP ONE



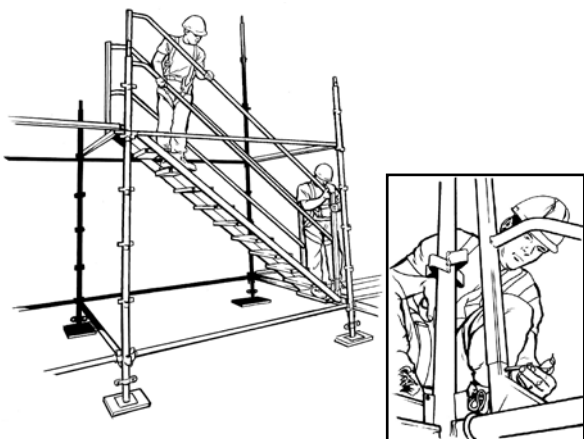
1. Set/Extend out a central staircase bay 4' 2" x 8' with 2 landing bays 4' 2" x 4' 2" at either end to form the base of the tower.

## STEP TWO



2. Erect next lift to suit and install general stair assembly. Care should be taken to place a dummy lift to allow access when installing staircase.

## STEP THREE



3. Handrails should be fitted on both sides of the stair assembly and secured using spring clips provided.

## STEP FOUR



4. The staircase is fitted with a securing device to prevent wind lift and should be secured before proceeding to the next level.

## STEP FIVE



5. All landing platforms should be decked with Steelstage/Battens and all platforms double handrailed. Toe boards are not required.

## STEP SIX

Repeat the process to further levels using the same sequence, ensuring at all times the use of safe temporary working platforms

**Scaffolding should always be erected and dismantled by competent persons. Safety Harnesses should always be worn and used in line with NASC guidance SG4:05**
